Health and Safety Evaluation of School Buildings Checklist and Guidance

The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) has revised the annual Health and Safety Evaluation of School Buildings Checklist and Guidance.

The <u>Health and Safety Evaluation of School Buildings Checklist and Guidance</u> can be found on the NJDOE's <u>New Jersey Quality Single Accountability Continuum (NJQSAC) website</u>.

- The evaluation checklist must be completed annually, by December 30, by appropriate local educational agencies (LEAs) personnel and kept on file for inspection.
- Annually, by January 30, the chief school administrator of every LEA must submit to the county office of
 education an assurance that the checklists have been completed for every school building.
- LEAs undergoing a full NJQSAC review must submit the Health and Safety Evaluation of School Buildings Facilities Checklist to the county office no later than November 15 this year.
