As part of Earth Day 2024 celebrations, the NJDOE is inviting New Jersey school districts to participate in the Action for Earth campaign throughout the month of April. This celebration challenges New Jersey school districts to plan and share activities related to four themed weeks that engage students to be better stewards of their bodies, their communities, and their planet as they explore climate related challenges and solutions. The theme for this coming week is Nature & Wellness.

School districts can plan and participate in activities, events, and lessons that explore the theme. Students and teachers are encouraged to utilize existing green spaces on their school grounds and in their community or create new ones to engage in activities that support positive mental and physical wellbeing and care for their local environment.
