Work-Based Learning (WBL) Coordinator Training Opportunity

The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE), in collaboration with the Rutgers School of Public Health, New Jersey Safe Schools Program (NJSSP), is pleased to offer the Work-Based Learning (WBL, formerly known as structured learning experiences, SLE) coordinator training for endorsed career and technical education (CTE), agricultural education, business, human services-cosmetology, allied health, and/or family and consumer science teachers. This training is required for student placement and supervision in WBL experiences.
