Action Required: Gifted and Talented Education Service Report Submission

This memorandum reminds all local educational agencies (LEAs) scheduled for the 2024–2025 New Jersey Quality Single Accountability Continuum (NJQSAC) comprehensive review (Cohort 3) that, according to the "Strengthening Gifted and Talented Education Act" (P.L.2019,c.338), LEAs must submit an updated Gifted and Talented Education Service Report in the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) Homeroom by October 1, 2024.

Report Content

To ensure compliance with the Law, all reports must be submitted through a template in the NJDOE <u>Homeroom</u> portal and must include updates to the initial Gifted and Talented Education Service Report in the following areas:

- The gifted and talented continuum of services, policies, and procedures implemented in the school district for students in kindergarten through grade 12;
- The professional development opportunities provided for teachers, educational services staff, and school leaders about gifted and talented students, their needs, and educational development;
- Detailed information is available on the school district website regarding the policies and procedures used
 to identify students as gifted and talented and the continuum of services offered to gifted and talented
 students. The information on the website shall include the criteria used for determining eligibility for
 gifted and talented services, including the multiple measures used in the identification process, and any
 applicable timelines in the identification process; and
- The link to the website with the school district's complaint policy on gifted and talented education.
