## Two-Part Webinar Series on Human Trafficking Awareness and Prevention within Schools

January is National Human Trafficking Prevention Month. Human trafficking is a crime that has been reported in all 50 states with children and youth being common targets of related exploitation. It is critical that school staff members are properly trained and prepared to respond to instances of suspected trafficking.

The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) is pleased to offer interested school staff the opportunity to attend a two-part training series on human trafficking which includes information on risk factors, warning signs, and how schools can support and promote the awareness and prevention of human trafficking.
