School Safety Summer Symposiums

The New Jersey Department of Education's Office of School Preparedness and Emergency Planning is pleased to offer a School Safety Summer Symposium. This half-day symposium is being offered at two locations. Sessions will include information presented by the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management (NJOEM) on the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Public Assistance Program. This program provides supplemental financial assistance to state, county, and local governments and certain non-profit organizations, to support response and recovery activities resulting from a federal disaster.
