Intimate Partner Violence in the Deaf Community

Ali Matheson, Deaf Services Program Manager for the Deaf Services Program at the Domestic Abuse & Sexual Assault Crisis Center of Warren County, will be conducting a virtual presentation on how Intimate Partner Violence (IPV) might look different in the Deaf and hard-of-hearing community, and how to address this in schools.
