

Student Safety Data System Opening

The Student Safety Data System (SSDS) is open for reporting for the 2024-25 school year. The SSDS collects incidents of violence, vandalism, weapons, substances, harassment, intimidation and bullying (HIB), restraint, seclusion and other incidents leading to removal, as well as HIB trainings and programs conducted to support anti-bullying efforts. The report period 1 submission due date is January 31, 2025.
