### **Background**

<u>Climate Week</u> is the largest annual climate event of its kind, bringing together hundreds of events and activities across New York City in partnership with the United Nations. Each year, business leaders, political change makers, and civil society representatives gather to champion change that is already happening in the transition to a net zero carbon emissions future. This year's theme is "It's Time." New Jersey continues to be a proud participant in Climate Week.

New Jersey has a <u>climate resilience strategy</u> and <u>state-wide resilience action plan</u> to address and mitigate climate change's impacts, which include the implementation of educational initiatives. Through continued support and advocacy for climate change initiatives by Governor Phil Murphy and First Lady Tammy Murphy, New Jersey became the first state in the nation to incorporate climate change education across content areas in the <u>K-12 New Jersey Student Learning Standards</u>.
