## **First Through Third Grade Implementation Guidelines**

The First through Third Grade Implementation Guidelines is a resource which empowers all educational professionals to provide children with developmentally appropriate learning experiences. LEAs are encouraged to use the guidelines as a springboard for discussion and action, ensuring that all first through third grade classrooms are developmentally appropriate spaces. *The First through Third Grade Implementation Guidelines* reflect the collaborative efforts of the New Jersey Department of Education and early childhood professionals across the state bringing current research and best practices together in one usable document for school administrators, teachers, instructional coaches, and families to meet the needs of all learners.
