Call for Applications for Person-Centered Approaches in Schools and **Transition (PCAST) Training**

The New Jersey Department of Education, Office of Special Education, in partnership with the Boggs Center on Disability and Human Development, invites school districts to apply for participation in the Person-Centered Approaches in Schools and Transition (PCAST) 2025-2026 Cohort. Person-centered approaches are applicable to all students ages 3 through 21, and each year a select cohort of school districts receives intensive multi-year customized training and technical assistance on this practice.

PCAST staff from the Boggs Center work collaboratively with school leadership, implementation teams, and other staff to explore person-centered approaches. This may include, but is not limited to, facilitating individual person-centered plans, implementing group person-centered practices in classrooms, developing internal training capacity, and creating skills related to person-centered IEP meetings and processes when applicable. The major focus of this practice is to improve educational and post-school outcomes for students with disabilities.

The PCAST project has been built on a foundation of respect, trust, and partnership with educators, families, and students working together to provide holistic person-centered support for students in both primary and secondary education. All person-centered approaches involve a continuous process of discovery that engages educators, students, and their families with the goal of developing a deep understanding of each student and supporting their personal vision for a positive future.
