Indicator 7: Preschool Outcomes – Child Outcomes Summary (COS) Updates

This broadcast includes the updates and additional resources related to Indicator 7: Preschool Outcomes – Child Outcomes Summary (COS) Process. Indicator 7 in New Jersey's State Performance Plan measures the percent of preschool children aged 3 through 5 with Individualized Education Programs (IEPs) who demonstrate improved social-emotional skills, early academics, and behavior. This indicator is part of a broader effort to ensure that children with disabilities receive the support and services necessary to achieve their full potential. Please familiarize yourselves with the evolution of Indicator 7 for preschool outcomes to ensure accurate and consistent implementation.

Updates

- The timeline for completion of the COS at entry and exit has been updated from within 60 days to within 30 days of starting or ending preschool special education services.
- A new NJDOE Developmental Milestone Tool to be used to support age-anchoring. This means it will help us gauge a child's development by comparing their skills to the milestones typically achieved by children of the same age.
- The revised COS Forms (A and B) now align with the Homeroom Preschool Application, and they include the student's educational placement at the start and end of preschool services, as well as their proposed kindergarten placement upon exit.
