NJDOE Seeks Public Comment on Proposed Revisions to the New Jersey Student Learning Standards in Career Readiness, Life Literacies, and Key Skills; Computer Science and Design Thinking; Science; Visual and Performing Arts; and World Languages

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:8-2.1(a)4, the New Jersey Department of Education (Department) is required to review the New Jersey Student Learning Standards (NJSLS). The Career Readiness, Life Literacies, and Key Skills; Computer Science and Design Thinking; Science; Visual and Performing Arts; and World Languages NJSLS are currently open for review and readoption. The Department is committed to engaging stakeholders in collaborative efforts to ensure the NJSLS are rigorous, research-based, and prepare students to be college- and career-ready.

Educators from across the state worked collaboratively to develop the proposed revisions over the past year, and the Department now seeks broader stakeholder input to refine the proposed standards. These proposed NJSLS revisions can be found on the <u>State Board of Education's webpage</u> for review. Presentations providing a broad overview of the process and specifics of each content area from the State Board of Education's meetings in November and December 2025 can be found on the <u>State Board of Education 2025 agenda webpage</u>.
