## **Climate Change Learning Collaboratives Culminating Events**

In April 2024, the New Jersey Department of Education established regional <u>Climate Change Learning</u> <u>Collaboratives</u> (CCLCs) at Stockton University, Rutgers University – New Brunswick, Monmouth University, and Ramapo College of New Jersey. The CCLCs provide local education agencies (LEAs) with free professional development, technical assistance, and networking opportunities to aid in their implementation of the New Jersey Student Learning Standards (NJSLS) supporting climate change education across all nine content areas.
