Notice of Changes to the Procedures for Due Process Hearing Requests

This memorandum outlines important updates to the procedures for filing due process hearing requests with the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE), Office of Special Education (OSE). The federal District Court of New Jersey appointed a compliance monitor on April 11, 2024 for the purpose of implementing a <u>Consent Order and Settlement Agreement</u>. These changes are being implemented in response to <u>recommendations</u> from the court-appointed monitor regarding these settlement activities. Effective January 15, 2025, the OSE will adopt the following updates to the current due process procedures.

When a district board of education files a request for a due process hearing, the matter will be immediately transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) for a due process hearing. If the parties wish to participate in mediation, they must notify the OAL. This immediate transmittal for due process requests filed by district boards of education will take effect on January 15, 2025.

Additionally, the OSE will provide contemporaneous notice to the OAL upon the filing of each request for a due process hearing. This advance notification will precede the formal transmittal and alert the OAL of new cases. Upon receipt of this notice, the OAL will open the case file and begin tracking all associated timelines. The contemporaneous notice requirement will also take effect on January 15, 2025.
