2024-2025 Application for Special Education Extraordinary Aid (EXAID)

The Fiscal Year (FY) 2026 Appropriations Act includes \$420 million of Extraordinary Special Education Aid to reimburse local educational agencies (LEAs) for costs incurred in FY2025 (i.e., the 2024-2025 school year). The award notices are available through the “School Aid” link on the New Jersey Department of Education’s (NJDOE) [Homeroom](#) webpage.

The award is based upon the individual student’s primary placement in one of three categories:

1. *Student educated in a public-school program with non-disabled peers:* For those direct instructional and support services costs in excess of \$40,000, an LEA shall receive aid equal to 90 percent of the amount of that excess.
2. *Student educated in a public school with only disabled peers:* For those direct instructional and support services costs in excess of \$40,000, an LEA shall receive aid equal to 75 percent of the amount of that excess.
3. *Student educated in a private school:* For tuition costs in excess of \$55,000, an LEA shall receive aid equal to 75 percent of the amount of that excess.

The final award amount was then prorated for the amount of available funding (as shown on Line F of the notice) to arrive at a payment amount.

LEAs can expect the payment to be made through the Automated Clearing House (ACH) in September. Reimbursement funds should be recorded as revenue and a receivable in the LEA’s detailed general ledger for FY2025 as “Extraordinary Aid” in revenue account 10-3131. Extraordinary Aid amounts that can be clearly documented as having not been appropriated during FY2025 may be used as an allowable adjustment for the audited excess surplus calculation, and, in accordance with [N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-13.3\(d\)6](#), LEAs may also appropriate that amount in the next fiscal year (i.e., the 2025-2026 school year) without approval from the Commissioner of Education.
