Launch of the New Jersey Grants Management System

The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) is pleased to announce the launch of its new Grants Management System (NJGMS). This new platform is designed to streamline the grants application, approval, and management processes for all grantees across the state.

Accessing NJGMS

Local educational agencies (LEAs) will not need a new login for NJGMS. The current User ID and Password used in the Electronic Web-Enable Grant System (EWEG) will be used to access the new platform. To log into NJGMS, users will need to take the following steps:

- Go to NJDOE Homeroom Click on EWEG;
- Log into EWEG using your current User ID, Password, and County District Code;
- From the Dashboard, click on the NJGMS (2026 ESEA, IDEA and Perkins) Link; and
- You will automatically be logged into the new platform and can begin work on your FY26 applications.

At this time, the Organizational Profile (previously known as Central Contacts) and Unique Entity Identifier – System for Award Management (UEI-SAM) Application are live in the system. LEAs will only need to update the information if necessary and agree to the Assurances in the Organizational Profile to create the FY26 Formula Grants when they become available. Additional information regarding the release and allocations for the Perkins Secondary, Perkins Post-Secondary, IDEA, and ESEA grants will be forthcoming.

All FY25 Formula Grants will still be available and accessible in the EWEG System. LEAs will be closing out FY25 Formula Grants and all Discretionary Grants in EWEG.
