This April the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) invites New Jersey school districts to participate in Action for Earth in recognition of Earth Day 2025.

Earth Day is an annual event held on April 22 to demonstrate support for environmental protection. First held on April 22, 1970, it now includes a wide range of events coordinated globally by Earthday.org and engages 1 billion people in more than 193 countries. The official theme for 2025 is "Our Power, Our Planet."

In recognition of Earth Day 2025, the NJDOE is inviting New Jersey school districts to participate in a month-long Action for Earth in April 2025. This celebration challenges New Jersey school districts to plan and share activities related to five themed weeks that engage students, educators, and families to be stewards of their communities and their planet as they explore climate-related challenges and solutions. The five themed weeks will be:

• Healthy Communities: April 7–11

• Educating for a Healthy Planet: April 14–18

Protect and Preserve: April 21–25

• Building Green Spaces: April 28–May 2
