Using Individuals with Disabilities Education Act Funds for Community Based Instruction

This memorandum clarifies the expectations and requirements for providing Community-Based Instruction (CBI) to students with disabilities. Under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and New Jersey Administrative Code (N.J.A.C. 6A:14-1.1(d)1), all special education and related services outlined in a student's Individualized Education Program (IEP) must be provided at no cost to families. When CBI is included in a student's IEP, all associated costs – such as transportation, materials, entry fees, or other expenses – must also be covered at no cost to the family.

Local education agencies (LEAs) may use state, local, and federal IDEA funds to cover costs associated with providing CBI to students with disabilities. LEAs are encouraged to review their existing policies, procedures, and practices to ensure that families of students with disabilities are not asked to cover the costs of these services through fundraising or any other means.
