School Performance Reports: New Webpage

The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) has launched a new [School Performance Reports webpage](#). This change is part of the NJDOE's transition to the New Jersey Statewide Longitudinal Education Data System (NJSLEDS). The NJDOE has moved all existing report data through the 2023-2024 school year to the new webpage; there is no new data being released at this time. The old webpage is no longer available. The NJDOE expects to release new redesigned reports for the 2024-2025 school year in spring 2026.

New Webpage Updates

The new School Performance Reports webpage has PDF versions of the previously released School Performance Reports available for the 2016-2017 through 2023-2024 school years. Users can search for a school or district name or select a state report to find the PDF reports. For the 2023-2024 reports only, a new summary report dashboard is also available that includes all data that was available in the previously released summary reports along with other key data elements. These dashboards, which include a new state-level summary report, allow users to easily navigate to school performance data at the school, district, and state level. They can be found by searching for a school, district, or the state with school year 2023-2024 selected and selecting Summary Report. For prior years, the previously released Summary Report PDF will be available. The PDF versions of the reports may include links to the old webpage, so some links within the PDFs may no longer work.

Databases that include all the data in the reports are available for 2011-2012 through 2023-2024 on the [Downloadable Data page](#).

Feedback and Suggestions for 2024-2025

The NJDOE is currently planning for the 2024-2025 reports. These reports will be the first launched since the NJDOE's transition to NJSLEDS. The NJDOE expects that all data available in the 2023-2024 reports will remain in the 2024-2025 reports, but additional information and report options may be added for the 2024-2025 school year. The new reports will be designed to give readers a clearer, more engaging experience by providing user-friendly visuals and simple filters that allow families, educators, and community members to readily explore key school performance insights. The NJDOE also anticipates that the new report design will enable more real-time updates and improvements to School Performance Report data as the platform is more cohesively integrated with NJSLEDS source data.
