NJGPA-A Centralized Reporting System (CRS) Virtual Training Sessions

In preparation for the release of the New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment-Adaptive (NJGPA-A) Spring 2026 results, the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE), with our assessment partner Cambium Assessment, Inc. (CAI), is offering CRS training for the new platform and assessments. CRS is the reporting system used to access the NJGPA-A assessment results and reporting resources.

Session Information

These sessions will provide district personnel with the opportunity to engage with representatives from the NJDOE and CAI. The presentation will provide a general overview of the CRS, and how to access the Individual Student Reports (ISRs) and aggregate school and district reports.
