2026-2027 Auxiliary and Remedial Services for Students in Nonpublic Schools (Chapters 192-193) Maximum Rates and Funding Guidance

Beginning in the 2026-2027 school year, state law ([P.L.2025, c.252](#)) modified the way school districts will receive funding to provide certain services to students enrolled in nonpublic schools located in the districts' boundaries. Previously, school districts received an initial allocation for Auxiliary and Remedial Services for Students in Nonpublic Schools (Chapters 192-193) and could also apply for additional funding throughout the school year. Under the new law, school districts will instead receive reimbursement for actual expenditures on a quarterly basis.

The 2026-2027 approved maximum annual and monthly reimbursement rates for Auxiliary and Remedial Services for Students in Nonpublic Schools (Chapters 192-193) and reimbursement guidance are available at the following link under the "Funding Guidance" section:
