## **Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Part B State Fiscal Year 2027 Electronic Grant Application Information**

The IDEA Part B State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2027 allocations will be posted on the New Jersey Department of Education's (NJDOE) [Office of Special Education's IDEA Allocations webpage](#) on or before June 30, 2026. IDEA Part B Section 611 (Basic 3-21) and Section 619 (Preschool 3-5) awards are distributed on a formula basis to Local Education Agencies (LEAs) and state agencies. A detailed description of the data used in the individual allocation formulas is located under the allocation tabs within the IDEA consolidated grant application. Eligible agencies should use these amounts for planning purposes. Allocation levels may change due to factors such as fluctuations in available federal funding, enrollment, poverty indicators, and the number of children with disabilities served. Additionally, please be advised that base allocation adjustments may be required during the project period in accordance with 34 CFR §300.705(b)(2) and §300.816(b).
