## Tuition-Waived Graduate Level Courses

The Holocaust Resource and Education Center of Kean University is announcing a professional development opportunity for educators, professionals, and administrative staff. Two tuition-waived graduate-level courses are being offered through the Holocaust Resource and Education Center of Kean University.

*Teaching the Holocaust* will be offered in the Fall semester, followed by *Teaching Prejudice Reduction* in the Spring semester. Courses are valued around \$800 per credit; both are tuition-waived by Kean University and the Holocaust Resource Foundation on the condition that both courses are completed by the attendee, and their district or organization are members of the Council on Global Education and Citizenship.
