## **2026-2027 Auxiliary and Remedial Services for Students in Nonpublic Schools (Chapters 192-193) Quarterly Reimbursements Guidance**

Effective with the 2026-2027 school year, P.L.2025, c.252 modified the way school districts will receive funding to provide certain services to students enrolled in nonpublic schools located in the districts' boundaries. Under the new law, school districts will receive reimbursement for actual expenditures on a quarterly basis. Previously, school districts received an initial allocation for Auxiliary and Remedial Services for Students in Nonpublic Schools (Chapters 192-193) and could also apply for additional funding throughout the school year.

The 2026-2027 approved maximum annual and monthly reimbursement rates for Auxiliary and Remedial Services for Students in Nonpublic Schools (Chapters 192-193) and reimbursement guidance was made available via the [broadcast memo sent July 15](#) under the Funding Guidance section on the [Auxiliary and Remedial Services for Nonpublic Schools \(Chapters 192 and 193\)](#) webpage.

The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) will reimburse school districts for actual expenditures on a quarterly basis using the new Chapters Reimbursement system available on the [NJDOE Homeroom](#) webpage.

The Chapters Reimbursement system currently is open for school districts to submit their reimbursement requests for the quarter ending September 2026. Districts will be required to submit requests for each month of the quarter, and the monthly reimbursement requests for the number of actual services provided and actual expenditure must be supported by monthly invoices. For the first quarter ending September 30, the reimbursement requests will be submitted for July, August and September, and must include the invoices uploaded for each of these months.

Certified reimbursement requests from the first quarter are **due by October 16, 2026**, and will be paid by the end of the month. Any first quarter submissions that are certified after October 16 will be paid at the end of the quarter in which they are certified (e.g. January 2027).

The annual schedule for requesting submissions and reimbursements is available at this link, and it is critical that expenditures for 2026-2027 are submitted as per the timelines listed on the [Quarterly Submission and Reimbursement Timeline](#) webpage.

Under the new statute school districts are required to initially provide services and subsequently, on a quarterly basis, request reimbursement from the State. As such, districts' accounting of revenue under the programs will need to be as described on the [Accounting Guidance](#) page.

All users of the Chapters Reimbursement application must have a district-level Homeroom User Account to log into the Chapters Reimbursement system. Any users who had access to the discontinued Additional Funding system ADDL will automatically have access to Chapters Reimbursement system. Users of the Chapters 192-193 Report for Auxiliary and Remedial Services will *not* have access to the Chapters Reimbursement system unless they also had access to ADDL.
