Mr. Kaplan made a motion to change the order of items on the Board's agenda, which Dr. Nagy seconded. The motion was carried unanimously.

Dr. Higgins read a resolution commending Arlene Lutz, the Board's Legal Coordinator, for her service to the State Board of Examiners. Dr. Saatkamp moved that the Board adopt the resolution and Mr. Gay seconded the motion, which was carried by a unanimous vote.
