Securing Our Children's Future Bond Act CTE Grant Second Round Eligibility

The Securing Our Children's Future Bond Act implementing [regulations](#) set limits on the number and amount of CTE Expansion grants to county vocational school districts. The regulations limit the Department to awarding grants to a maximum of four large projects (those with total costs exceeding \$25 million). Three large projects were funded in the first round of the grant applications; thus the Department may only award one remaining large project grant. Additionally, districts may not receive both a large and small project grant, and the total amount of small project grants that may be awarded to a single district are limited to project costs of \$25 million. Due to the district matching requirement, a maximum of \$25 million total project costs equals a \$18,750,000 maximum grant award. District applications will be limited based on the substantially approved grants in the first round and these regulatory requirements as set forth below:

- Total Statewide Grant Funds Remaining: **\$52,095,232**
- Number of Statewide Grants Remaining:
 - Large Grant – 1 remaining
 - Small Grants – not limited; depends on remaining funds
- Districts that received a large project award in Round 1 and **are not eligible** to submit a Second Round CTE Expansion Grant application:
 - Atlantic
 - Middlesex
 - Bergen
- Districts that did not receive a grant in Round 1 and **are eligible** to apply for a grant to fund a large project:
 - Burlington
 - Salem
 - Mercer
 - Monmouth
 - Essex
 - Warren
