***MINIMUM PRICES THAT CAN BE CHARGED FOR ADULT MEALS**

Lunch: N.J.A.C. 2:36-1.10 requires that adult meal prices shall be established to cover all costs associated with production and service of the adult meal. There is no maximum set for adult prices. At least \$.50 more than the price of a student's lunch by grade level as a minimum.

Breakfast: N.J.A.C. 2:36-1.10 requires that adult meal prices shall be established to cover all costs associated with production and service of the adult meal. There is no maximum set for adult prices. At least \$.40 more than the price of a student's breakfast by grade level as a minimum.

Please note: These are minimum charges for adult meals. We strongly encourage you to establish an adult meal price that will cover all costs associated with the production and service of that meal.
