### MINIMUM PRICES THAT CAN BE CHARGED FOR ADULT MEALS

**Lunch:** N.J.A.C. 2:36-1.10 requires that adult meal prices be established to cover all costs associated with production and service of the adult meal. There is no maximum set for adult prices. At a minimum, schools must charge at least \$.50 more than the price of a student's lunch by grade level.

**Breakfast:** N.J.A.C. 2:36-1.10 requires that adult meal prices be established to cover all costs associated with production and service of the adult meal. There is no maximum set for adult prices. At a minimum, schools must charge at least \$.40 more than the price of a student's breakfast by grade level.
