The following questions were posed during the technical assistance session. Answers have been prepared by the Office of Career Readiness.

Question 1:	Does the applicant need to develop a curriculum with each individual county vocational school district (CVSD) partner or could the curriculum be developed with the collective group of CVSD partners?
Answer:	The decision about how best to develop curriculum with the county vocational school partners is up to the applicant. The applicant should clearly describe the plan to do this in the project description section of the application (see 2.2.2 Project Description: Partnerships on page 13 of the NGO).
Question 2:	Will there be one grantee for the entire state of New Jersey or three grantees for each of the three regions – north, south and central?
Answer:	There will be one grantee for the state of New Jersey (see 1.4 Statutory/Regulatory Source and Funding on page 4 of the NGO).
Question 3:	If a two year institute of higher education chooses to apply and is unable to provide master's-level credit to teachers who participate in the CTE CEEP program, will the applicant need to partner with an institute of higher education that offers a graduate program?

Answer: The grantee will be responsible for obtaining approval to award master's-level credit to eligible CTE CE educators, and establishing eligibility, number of credits, additional coursework requirements, and costs (see Objective 2.3 on page 15 of the NGO). If the grantee is not able to award master's-level credit at their own institution, arrangements must be made with another institution to award this credit.
