offer some funding for hubs for an additional two years?

Answer: NJDOE funding is currently only available for the 2020 fiscal year.

Question: Following the grant period we obviously hope to be able to sustain our hub through grants from the NSF

and other sources, however, is it permissible to also consider charging districts/educators fees after the

grant period is over?

Answer: Computer Science (CS) hubs may not charge a fee for their services during the grant period.
