Maud Dahme Award:

Awarded to a student or an educator who has demonstrated the moral courage of an upstander in regard to humanity, prejudice and discrimination.

Criteria:

- Assists students (and adults) to learn about right from wrong and to be an outstanding humane person.
- Develops knowledge and understanding in others of the importance of doing the right and moral thing
- Demonstrates qualities of moral courage, a sense of moral responsibility, and a respect for humanity in his/her actions
- Inspires others by the physical and moral courage, personal integrity, and sense of moral responsibility exhibited in his/her daily actions and in difficult situations affecting the human rights and lives of others
- Exhibits the attitudes, behaviors, and actions of an Upstander, not a Bystander
- Has learned or taught the lessons of the Holocaust, genocides, pogroms, and other acts of prejudice and hate and works to ensure that future generations also will have the opportunity to learn the lessons and to understand the importance of respect and tolerance for others

Venue – Presented at the end of school year at the Commission meeting.

Nominations for these awards presented by the New Jersey Commission on Holocaust Education may be accepted from private citizens, community and religious groups, Holocaust Centers, government officials, etc. All nominations will be reviewed by the Commission or a subcommittee established by the Commission with final selection made by the Commission.
