The record of this matter and the initial decision of the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) have been reviewed. Exceptions of petitioners¹ and replies thereto of the Board were timely filed in accordance with *N.J.A.C.* 1:1-18.4, and were fully considered by the Commissioner in making his determination herein.

Upon his independent and comprehensive review of the record in this matter, the Commissioner agrees with the Administrative Law Judge, that, as petitioners have failed to comply with the prehearing order of the court issued on February 11, 1998, and have also failed to file responsive papers to the Board's motion to dismiss, served upon petitioners' counsel on

¹ Petitioners' exceptions explain that their failure to present timely interrogatories was a result of counsel's inability to obtain required answers from one of the petitioners and his decision to withhold answers of the remaining six petitioners until he was able to secure answers from the seventh.

May 7, 1998, good cause exists, pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 1:1-14.14, to grant the Board's motion and to dismiss the within action.

Accordingly, the initial decision of the OAL is affirmed for the reasons stated therein. The Board's motion to dismiss the instant Petition of Appeal is hereby granted.²
