:

Whereas, the School Ethics Commission (Commission) has acted pursuant to the authority granted to it by *N.J.S.A.* 18A:12-21 *et seq.* to recommend removal of the above-named Board member from office for failure to attend the Board member training sessions required by *N.J.S.A.* 18A:12-33 and *N.J.A.C.* 6:3-9.4; and

Whereas, the Commission sent ample notice to the above-named Board member of his failure to attend such training sessions; and

Whereas, pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6:3-9.3(i), on April 26, 1999, the Commission issued an Order to Show Cause why a penalty should not be imposed for such failure; and

Whereas, the above-named Board member replied that raising his eight children prevented him from attending weekend sessions and his business obligations frequently take him out of the country, preventing him from attending previous training sessions in 1998 and 1999, but that he was scheduled to attend a September 1999 training session; and

Whereas, the Commission voted on May 26, 1999, to recommend that the abovenamed Board member be allowed to attend a June 1999 training session, if he can, and, if he fails to do so, that he be suspended until he does attend a required training; and

Whereas, the Commission further voted on May 26, 1999 that the above-named Board member be removed from office if he fails to so attend a required training program by the end of October 1999 and memorialized such decision through a resolution forwarded to the Commissioner of Education, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:12-29; and

Whereas, on June 7, 1999, the above-named Board member was afforded an opportunity to submit to the Commissioner of Education a response to said resolution; and

Whereas, no response was forthcoming; and

Whereas, the Commissioner of Education has confirmed the above-named Board member did not attend a June training session; and

Whereas, the Commissioner of Education has carefully considered the record of this matter and the decision of the Commission and concurs with and adopts as his own the recommendations of the Commission; now therefore

IT IS ORDERED that the above-named Board member, having failed to attend a June 1999 training session, is on this date suspended from office until he attends the required training program and, should he fail to do so by the end of October 1999, he shall be removed from office effective November 1, 1999.*
