COMMISSIONER OF EDUCATION DECISION

Whereas, the School Ethics Commission (Commission) has acted pursuant to the authority granted to it by *N.J.S.A.* 18A:12-21 *et seq.* to recommend removal of the above-named Board member from office for failure to attend the Board member training sessions required by *N.J.S.A.* 18A:12-33 and *N.J.A.C.* 6:3-9.4; and

Whereas, the Commission sent ample notice to the above-named Board member of his failure to attend such training sessions; and

Whereas, pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6:3-9.3(i), on April 26, 1999, the Commission issued an Order to Show Cause why a penalty should not be imposed for such failure; and

Whereas, the above-named Board member submitted a response to the Commission indicating that his family obligations and demanding work schedule precluded his prior attendance, but that he planned to attend the October 26, 1999 session; and

Whereas, the Commission voted on May 26, 1999 to recommend that the abovenamed Board member be allowed to attend a June 1999 training session, if he can, and, if he fails to do so, that he be suspended until he does attend a required training; and

Whereas, the Commission further voted on May 26, 1999 that the above-named Board member be removed from office if he fails to so attend a required training program by the end of October 1999 and memorialized such decision through a resolution forwarded to the Commissioner of Education, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:12-29; and

Whereas, on June 7, 1999, the above-named Board member was afforded an opportunity to submit to the Commissioner of Education a response to said resolution; and

Whereas, no response was forthcoming; and

Whereas, the Commissioner of Education has subsequently been informed by the Commission that the above-named Board member did in fact attend a June training session as directed¹; now therefore

IT IS ORDERED that the Commission's recommendation to suspend and/or remove the above-named Board member is accordingly declined as moot.²
