## **SYNOPSIS**

Petitioning teachers alleged the District improperly withheld their salary increments for the 1996-97 school year.

The ALJ concluded that Petitioner Sullivan (Petitioner Blazakis having withdrawn her petition) did not demonstrate by a preponderance of the credible evidence that the withholding of her salary increment was arbitrary, capricious or otherwise contrary to law and dismissed the petition. The Commissioner agreed with and adopted the recommended decision of the ALJ dismissing the petition for the reasons set forth in the initial decision.
