## **SYNOPSIS**

Petitioning parents challenged the Board's decision to expel H.R. for allegedly possessing a weapon (miniature baseball bat). Petitioners asserted that the Commissioner and State Board violated H.R.'s rights by failing to set uniform standards of suspension and expulsion.

The ALJ dismissed the matter as moot in view of the fact that H.R. was restored as a student in the District, his record was expunged, and petitioners' argument that this case represented a chance to deal with an issue of general public concern was not persuasive.

The Commissioner concurred and adopted the decision as his own.
