The record of this matter and advisement of petitioner's failure to appear transmitted to

the Commissioner by the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) pursuant to N.J.A.C. 1:1-14.4, along with

a copy of the notification sent to the parties by OAL on January 12, 2005, providing petitioner ten days to

submit an explanation for such nonappearance, have been reviewed. There being no explanation filed by

petitioner, the petition of appeal is hereby dismissed with prejudice due to petitioner's failure to appear at

hearing or provide an explanation for her nonappearance.

Notwithstanding the dismissal of the petition, the Commissioner notes that the Board's

Answer in this residency matter contained a counterclaim for tuition which was left unresolved by the

Administrative Law Judge. In that the record before the Commissioner contains no affidavit of a

responsible Board official attesting to the amount of tuition claimed by the Board as a consequence of the

ineligible attendance of petitioner's children in its schools, this matter is hereby remanded to the OAL for

supplementation of the record in this regard and an appropriate recommended order regarding the

payment of tuition.
