IN THE MATTER OF JIMMY GARCIA, : COMMISSIONER OF EDUCATION
UNION CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION, : DECISION
HUDSON COUNTY :

The record of this matter and the decision of the School Ethics Commission, forwarded to the Commissioner pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:12-29 solely for review of the Commission's recommended penalty, have been reviewed. Respondent did not file exceptions, nor was the Commission's underlying finding of violation appealed to the Commissioner pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:4.

Upon such review, the Commissioner concurs with the penalty of censure recommended by the Commission and additionally admonishes the respondent for failure to timely file the requisite disclosure statements, in that such delay has resulted in a waste of administrative and adjudicative time at both State and local levels.

Accordingly, the above-named respondent shall be censured as a school official found to have violated the School Ethics Act.
