On January 10, 2011, the Commissioner of Education (Commissioner) rendered a decision concurring with the November 23, 2010 recommendation of the School Ethics Commission (Commission) that the respondent charter school trustee be censured for failure to timely attend school

board member training in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:12-33.

Subsequently, by letter dated April 27, 2011, the Executive Director of the School Ethics

Commission advised the Commissioner that the Commission had voted on March 22, 2011 to vacate its

prior decision finding respondent in violation of the School Ethics Act. Based on additional information

submitted to the Commission by the respondent, the Commission re-examined the record and determined

that the respondent had served on the board of trustees of the Marion P. Thomas Charter School since

1998; therefore, the Commission found that Mr. Collins was not subject to the expanded training

requirements that became effective on March 15, 2007.

Accordingly, given that the finding of violation upon which it was based has now been

vacated by the Commission, the Commissioner's decision of January 10, 2011 is concomitantly

VACATED and shall be deemed of no force and effect.
