In reviewing appeals from decisions of the Board of Examiners, the Commissioner may

not substitute his judgment for that of the Board so long as the appellant received due process and the

Board's decision is supported by sufficient credible evidence in the record. Further, the Board's decision

should not be disturbed unless the appellant demonstrates that it was arbitrary, capricious or unreasonable.

*N.J.A.C.* 6A:4-4.1(a).

After full consideration of the record and all submissions, the decisions of the Board of

Examiners denying Ms. Kavazanjian's request are hereby affirmed.<sup>1</sup>
