SYNOPSIS

Pro-se petitioner challenged the determination of the respondent that he had not satisfied the requirements for a principal certificate. Subsequent to the filing of the appeal, petitioner obtained a Principal's Certificate of Eligibility.

The ALJ found that, as the petitioner in this case is no longer seeking the relief he originally sought because he now holds a Principal's Certificate of Eligibility, the matter is moot. Accordingly, the ALJ ordered that the case be dismissed as moot and the file be returned to the transmitting agency.

Upon review, the Commissioner adopted the Initial Decision of the OAL as the final decision in this matter and dismissed the petition.
