New Jersey Commissioner of Education Final Decision

In the Matter of Zakaria Kandiel, Board of Education of the Carlstadt-East Rutherford Regional School District, Bergen County.

The Commissioner has reviewed the record of this matter and the decision of the School Ethics Commission (SEC), finding that respondent violated the School Ethics Act for failure to timely complete board member training in accordance with *N.J.S.A.* 18A:12-33 and *N.J.A.C.* 6A:28-4.1. The SEC's decision was forwarded to the Commissioner for final determination on the recommended penalty pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:12-29(c). The SEC recommended a sanction of removal effective upon the adoption of the decision by the Commissioner. Alternatively, if the respondent completed the required training before the issuance of the Commissioner's final decision, the SEC recommended that respondent be suspended for 30 days. Ultimately, respondent completed the training after the SEC's May 19, 2020 decision. Respondent has neither filed exceptions to the recommended penalty nor instituted an appeal of the SEC's underlying finding of violation, pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:4-1 et seq.

Upon review, the Commissioner concurs with the penalty recommended by the SEC for respondent's failure to timely honor an obligation placed upon board members by law.

Accordingly, respondent is suspended, as of the date of this decision, from his position as a school official for violating the School Ethics Act.
