On September 26, 2022, a final agency decision was rendered in this matter, wherein the

Commissioner found J.C. liable for tuition in the amount of \$3,676.50, representing tuition for a period

of ineligible attendance by her minor child, J.C., in the Board's school district during the period from

February 10, 2022 through April 27, 2022. The Board subsequently requested that the Commissioner

seek entry of the assessment on the judgment docket of the Superior Court pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2A:58-

10. J.C. offered no reasons why the judgment against her should not be so docketed, although given an

opportunity by this agency to do so. Accordingly, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2A:58-10, Jacobs Communication is now

subject to entry of a judgment by the court in the amount of \$3,676.50, which represents the payment

ordered at the conclusion of the case before the Commissioner, with interest to accrue as provided by

law.
