At its meeting of November 2, 2006, the State Board of Examiners reviewed

information the Office of Criminal History Review (OCHR) had forwarded regarding

Alex Karas. On August 18, 2006, Karas had been arrested for aggravated sexual assault

and official misconduct. Karas currently holds a County Substitute credential, issued in

November 2005. At its meeting of December 7, 2006, the Board of Examiners voted to

issue Karas an Order to Show Cause.

Karas agreed to forfeit his credential with the force and effect of a revocation and

all attendant consequences and submitted an affidavit to that effect to the New Jersey

State Board of Examiners. At its meeting of March 29, 2007, the Board voted to accept

Karas' relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to N.J.A.C.

6A:9-17.8.

Accordingly, on this 29th day of March 2007 it is therefore ORDERED that the

revocation of Alex Karas' County Substitute credential be effective immediately. It is

further ORDERED that Karas return his credential to the Secretary of the State Board of

Examiners, Office of Licensure, PO Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of

the mailing date of this decision.
