JULIE DeFEO : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of October 22, 2009, the State Board of Examiners reviewed an affidavit Julie DeFeo had forwarded. After pleading guilty to Endangering the Welfare of a Child, the Court ordered DeFeo to forfeit her teaching certificates. DeFeo currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing, and a Teacher of Biological Science Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing, both issued in October 1996, and a Teacher of Biological Science certificate, issued in January 2000.

DeFeo agreed to forfeit her certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in her affidavit to that effect to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners. At its meeting of October 22, 2009, the Board voted to accept DeFeo's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9-17.8*.

Accordingly, on this 22nd day of October 2009 it is therefore ORDERED that the revocation of Julie DeFeo's Teacher of Elementary School and Teacher of Biological Science Certificates of Eligibility With Advanced Standing and Teacher of Biological Science certificate be effective immediately.
