EMMANUEL LOISEAU : ORDER OF REVOCATION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Emmanuel Loiseau as to why his teaching certificates should not be revoked or suspended. Loiseau currently holds a Teacher of Students With Disabilities Certificate of Eligibility, issued in September 2006 and a Teacher of Social Studies certificate, also issued in September 2006. The Mercer County Prosecutor's Office had notified the Board that Loiseau had been arrested for Endangering the Welfare of a Child and had been accepted into a Pretrial Intervention program in March 2008. Loiseau had allegedly inappropriately touched a 15 year old girl and during his police interview, had admitted to sexual contact with another 16 year old girl. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Loiseau presented a settlement proposal to the Board in which he would voluntarily relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation. After reviewing the settlement proposal, at its meeting of January 19, 2012, the Board voted to accept the proposal. Accordingly, on this 19th day of January 2012, Emmanuel Loiseau's Teacher of Students With Disabilities Certificate of Eligibility and Teacher of Social Studies certificate are hereby REVOKED effective immediately.
