JOHN MORRISON : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of May 17, 2012, the State Board of Examiners reviewed an affidavit that John Morrison had submitted. In April 2011, Morrison surrendered his Florida teaching certificates following allegations of inappropriate contact with students. In New Jersey, Morrison currently holds a Teacher of Music certificate, issued in May 1968.

Morrison agreed to relinquish his certificate with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners. At its meeting of May 17, 2012, the Board voted to accept Morrison's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9-17.8*.

Accordingly, on this 17th day of May 2012 it is therefore ORDERED that John Morrison's Teacher of Music certificate be REVOKED effective immediately.
