JENNALIN GARCIA-CALLE : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of January 17, 2014, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Union County Prosecutor's Office had submitted regarding Jennalin Garcia-Calle. Garcia-Calle pled guilty to Criminal Sexual Contact. On November 22, 2013, she was sentenced to three years' probation, ordered to comply with Megan's Law and ordered to forfeit her teaching certificates. Garcia-Calle currently holds a Teacher of Mathematics Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing, issued in July 2008 and a Teacher of Mathematics certificate, issued in January 2010.

Garcia-Calle agreed to relinquish her certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in her affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of January 17, 2014, the Board voted to accept Garcia-Calle's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9-17.8.

Accordingly, on this 17<sup>th</sup> day of January 2014 it is therefore ORDERED that Jennalin M. Garcia-Calle's Teacher of Mathematics Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing and her Teacher of Mathematics certificate be revoked effective immediately.
