JULES B. GROSS : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of July 15, 2014, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Camden County Prosecutor's Office had submitted regarding Jules B. Gross. On January 27, 2014, Gross pled guilty to Endangering the Welfare of a Child. Gross currently holds a Teacher of Spanish Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing, issued in January 1996 and a Teacher of Spanish certificate, issued in September 2002.

Gross agreed to relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of July 15, 2014, the Board voted to accept Gross' relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9-17.8.

Accordingly, on this 15th day of July 2014 it is therefore ORDERED that Jules B. Gross' Teacher of Spanish Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing and his Teacher of Spanish certificate be revoked effective immediately.
